

Yunnan College of Business Management 2025 Admissions

Regulations

Chapter I. General Provisions

Article 1 In accordance with the Education Law of the Peoples Republic of China, the Higher Education Law of the Peoples Republic of China, and the relevant policies and regulations of the education authorities, and in order to ensure the smooth implementation of the enrollment work, this charter is formulated in light of the actual situation of the university.

Article 2 School Name: Yunnan College of Business Management, School ID: 4153012560

Article 3 Nature of the university: A private full-time university with the qualification to independently issue undergraduate and college diplomas.

Article 4 Address of the school

Haixun Campus: No.296 Haitun Road, Wuhua District, Kunming City, Yunnan Province.

Anning Campus: No.17 Qilin Road, Vocational Education Park, Anning City, Kunming City, Yunnan Province.

Article 5 School Profile

Yunnan College of Business Management, a full-time undergraduate institution approved by the Ministry of Education, was founded in 1992 and is located in Kunming, the "Spring City". The college has two campuses in Anning and Haiyuan. It offers 46 undergraduate programs and 31 associate programs, covering disciplines such as economics, management, engineering, medicine, science, education, art, law, and literature. The college currently has 3 provincial first-class undergraduate programs and 36 Category C programs (national average level). The total value of teaching and research equipment is 18,175.860,000 yuan, 251 paper books in the collection.770,000 copies, 160 e-books.190,000 copies.

In recent years, the university has been recognized with 1 national first-class course and 16 provincial first-class courses. It has received 2 first prizes and 3 second

prizes in Yunnan Provinces Teaching Achievement Awards, completed 1 project under the second batch of National New Engineering Research and Practice Program, and secured 72 Ministry of Education industry-academia collaboration projects for talent development. One textbook was selected as part of the first batch of "14th Five-Year Plan" National Vocational Education Planning Textbooks. Students have won 134 national-level awards and 2,009 provincial/ministerial-level awards in academic competitions.

The school has successively won numerous honors, including Chinas Outstanding Private Education School, Yunnan Provinces First Batch of Applied Talent Training Demonstration Universities, Yunnan Provinces Civilized School, Yunnan Provinces Typical Experience University in Employment and Entrepreneurship, and Yunnan Provinces Typical Experience University in Innovation and Entrepreneurship. Its educational achievements have been widely reported by authoritative media such as CCTV, Peoples Daily, and Yunnan Daily. Since its establishment, the school has cultivated over 140,000 talents for the country, producing outstanding students such as Zhang Zhe, a "New Generation of Strong Nation Youth," and Yu Xuanjun and Chen Min, "Chinas Self-Reliance Stars for College Students."

Chapter II Organizational Structure and Responsibilities

Article 6 The university shall set up a leading group for enrollment, which shall be responsible for reviewing and formulating enrollment policies and enrollment scale, as well as studying and deciding major issues in the enrollment process.

Article 7 The Admissions Office of Yunnan College of Business Management is the permanent body responsible for organizing and implementing enrollment procedures. It ensures the implementation of enrollment policies, guarantees the transparency, fairness, and impartiality of the admission process, protects the legitimate rights and interests of both the institution and applicants, and manages daily enrollment-related operations.

Chapter 3 Enrollment Plan

Article 8 In accordance with national socio-economic development needs and taking into account the schools actual conditions regarding talent cultivation and educational resources, the institution shall comprehensively determine provincial and major-specific enrollment plans by holistically evaluating factors including provincial (autonomous region, municipality) student demographics, graduate employment and further education trends, regional coordinated development, national key support policies, and historical enrollment patterns.

Article 9 The enrollment plan and major of each province (autonomous region or municipality directly under the Central Government) shall be subject to the local provincial enrollment and examination administration department.

Chapter 4 Admission Principles

Article 10 The admission ratio shall be determined according to the requirements of the provincial enrollment authorities according to the source of students in each province (autonomous region or municipality).

Article 11 Admissions shall follow the "score priority, preference adherence" principle, referencing students comprehensive quality evaluation results. Candidates will be selected based on their admission scores (including policy-based bonus points) in a merit-based manner. Major preferences shall be allocated according to the "score priority" principle, fully respecting candidates preferences without establishing major "grade differentials". Within the same admission batch, candidates admitted to this university shall be ranked from highest to lowest scores and admitted sequentially based on the score priority principle. If a candidate fails to secure admission in all preferred majors, those willing to accept major adjustments will be reassigned to available majors, while those unwilling to accept adjustments will be rejected.

Article 12 The admission committee of the province, autonomous region or municipality directly under the Central Government where the candidate is located shall implement the policy of adding or reducing the score.

Article 13 In case of equal admission scores, candidates shall be ranked and admitted according to the ranking rules of the same score in the source province.

Article 14 Admission principles for art majors

- (1) The results of the provincial joint examination or unified examination for art majors organized by the provincial enrollment examination authorities shall be recognized.
- (2) For candidates meeting both the local art undergraduate and associate degree admission thresholds in both specialized and general academic examinations, the comprehensive score will be calculated as follows: 50% of the general academic score multiplied by 50% and 50% of the specialized score multiplied by 750/300. Admissions will be based on the comprehensive score ranking from highest to lowest.
- (3) If the comprehensive score of the candidates is the same, the ranking and admission shall be carried out according to the ranking rules of the same score in the source province.
- (4) In case of conflict with the admission rules of the source place, the admission rules of the source place shall prevail.

Article 15 Admission principles for sports majors

- (1) The unified examination results of sports majors in the source provinces (autonomous regions and municipalities) shall be recognized.
- (2) Under the premise that the scores of both professional courses and cultural courses meet the local admission control line for sports majors and junior colleges, the candidates will be selected according to the ranking of sports majors from high to low.
- (3) If the candidates have the same major score, the ranking and admission will be carried out according to the ranking rules of the same score in the source province.
- (4) In case of conflict with the admission rules of the source place, the admission rules of the source place shall prevail.

Article 16 If the contents of this enrollment regulations are inconsistent with the enrollment documents of the candidates province, the documents of the provincial enrollment and examination authorities shall prevail.

Article 17 When the school can meet the first major preference of the examinee, for special reasons, the examinee voluntarily applies for admission to the non-first major

preference, and the school can respect the examinees willingness to adjust in principle.

Article 18 There is no restriction on the proportion of male and female in each major.

Article 19 The physical examination standards shall be implemented in accordance with the "Guidelines on Physical Examination for College Admissions" jointly issued by the Ministry of Education, the Ministry of Health, and the China Disabled Persons Federation, as well as the "Notice on Canceling Hepatitis B Testing in College Admissions" issued by the General Office of the Ministry of Education and the General Office of the Ministry of Health.

Article 20 After the admission, candidates can log on to the admission information website of each province (autonomous region or municipality directly under the Central Government) or the official website of the university to check the admission results.

Chapter V Admission Qualification Examination

Article 21 All newly admitted students must present their admission notices and complete registration procedures at the university within the specified timeframe. Those unable to register on time must submit a written request to the Admissions Office in advance. Registration may only be postponed with official approval. Students who fail to register within the deadline without authorization will be deemed to have automatically forfeited their admission eligibility. Upon enrollment, the university will conduct comprehensive reviews in accordance with the Ministry of Education's regulations, including re-examining academic records and conducting health assessments. Students failing these evaluations will be subject to appropriate disciplinary measures as stipulated in the "Regulations on Student Management in Higher Education Institutions" issued by the Ministry of Education.

Chapter VI. DIPLOMAS

Article 22 Upon completion of the program, students who achieve satisfactory academic performance will be awarded a full-time undergraduate or associate degree certificate from Yunnan College of Business Management, officially registered with the Ministry of Education. The degree is nationally recognized, granting graduates the

same benefits as those from regular higher education institutions. Undergraduate graduates meeting the degree requirements will receive a Bachelors degree certificate from Yunnan College of Business Management.

Chapter VII Incentives

Article 23 The university fully implements national financial aid policies, establishing an eight-in-one support system encompassing scholarships, grants, student loans, subsidies, work-study programs, tuition reductions, exemptions, and repayment assistance. This comprehensive framework includes various scholarships and grants established by the national and Yunnan provincial governments, student loans based on home-region credit, as well as university-level scholarships, work-study opportunities, tuition waivers, and hardship assistance, providing all-round support for students from economically disadvantaged families to complete their studies. Upon receiving admission notices, students should visit the Student Financial Aid Center at the Education and Sports Bureau of their registered county (city, district) before enrollment registration to consult and complete relevant procedures.

Chapter VIII Fee Standards

Article 24 The tuition fee for regular undergraduate students is 20,000 yuan per student per academic year for law majors, 24,000 yuan per student per academic year for medical majors, 29,000 yuan per student per academic year for art majors, and 22,000 yuan per student per academic year for other majors.

Article 25 Tuition fees for regular colleges and universities: The schools fees shall be implemented in strict accordance with the approved standards. If there is any change in the fee standards, the latest tuition fees filed by the Department of Education and the Development and Reform Commission of Yunnan Province shall be implemented.

Chapter IX Supplementary Provisions

Article 26 The university strictly complies with the enrollment requirements set by the Ministry of Education, ensuring a fair, transparent, standardized, and orderly admission process. It neither entrusts any intermediary agencies nor individuals to

conduct enrollment procedures, nor does it charge any fees related to the admission process.

Article 27 These regulations govern the 2025 undergraduate and associate degree admissions for Yunnan College of Business Management. Effective immediately upon publication, all previous admission policies inconsistent with these provisions shall be nullified, and these regulations shall prevail. This charter is interpreted by the Admissions Office of Yunnan College of Business Management.
